The Dreaded Spotted Wing Drosophila...



Since the discovery of Spotted Wing Drosophila (SWD) in the Pacific Northwest years ago, there has been a lot of research done to better understand the pest. While there is a great deal of information on the life cycle and habits of SWD, unfortunately to date there is not an effective integrated pest management strategy. This means spraying on more of a schedule for control, rather than relying on trap counts for spray timings. Traps provide information on when the pest is present but are not effective for determining when to spray. Since the lifecycle of SWD is so short it has the ability to reproduce very quickly and infest fruit very quickly. Fruit is considered to be vulnerable to SWD at the first sign of color and up to harvest. Canopy management can be effective in decreasing the habitat and activity of SWD in crops.

With the continued use of insecticides to protect fruit from this pest there is always the potential for resistance. To ensure that we are able to control SWD for years to come it is necessary to look at a variety of insecticides with different modes of action. Avoid using products from the same FRAC group, back to back, in your spray programs. With a good percentage of the fruit from the Pacific Northwest being exported, always check with your fruit buyers that there are no specific maximum residue level issues for the markets you are shipping to. Be sure to work with both your OVS Agronomist and your packer or marketer when developing management strategies for SWD to maintain high quality fruit for the markets you serve.

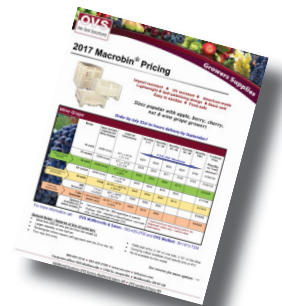
