DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Immediately call a POISON CENTER, doctor or physician. Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do then continue rinsing. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove or take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water or shower. Call a poison center, doctor, chemical manufacturer, importer, or distributor to specify the appropriate source of emergency medical advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison center, doctor, chemical manufacturer, importer, or distributor to specify the appropriate source of emergency medical advice Unless advised otherwise by a poison control center or doctor, have person rinse mouth with water, if able. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Do NOT induce vomiting.

IF INHALED: If breathing is difficult, remove person to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, and then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
